Financial support for conference attendees: LMS and Heilbronn

The London Mathematical Society and the Heilbronn Institute for Mathematical Research have both generously given grants to the conference to support the attendance of PhD students and early career researchers who would not otherwise be able to come. Preference (for LMS and HIMR funding only) will be given to the following groups: PhD students at UK universities; participants who are women, or from other groups traditionally under represented in mathematics; people with caring responsibilities. Following the LMS sustainable events policy, we also have a preference for attendees whose travel will have a low environmental cost (in particular, avoiding long-haul jet travel), and attendees coming from Scotland or mainland Europe are encouraged to consider travelling by train, even if this would be more expensive than flying.

For participants supported by these grants, the conference would expect to provide single accommodation for the 5 nights 30 August - Friday 4 September in the block of rooms the conference has reserved at Jesus College, plus a named contribution towards travel costs, which would be paid to the participant after the conference, upon presentation by e-mail or at the conference of travel receipts totalling at least the offered contribution.

To apply for support to attend the conference, participants should e-mail Naomi Kraker at admin@claymath.org by 1 June 2026, including the following information:

- That you are asking for support from LMS/Heilbronn funds.
- A brief CV, including name, career stage (PhD student, postdoc etc), and research interests.
- Dates you want to attend the conference.
- Budget for travel requested, and means (plane, rail etc).
- Whether you belong to an under-represented group in mathematics.
- The name and e-mail address of an academic referee (supervisor preferred for PhD students), who you should ask to send a supporting letter to Naomi Kraker at admin@claymath.org by 1 June 2026.
